ANNUAL REPORT 2021-22

The motto of the College is to focus on the objectives of education, impart employability skills and mould the students into responsible citizens of India. VSR Government Degree & P.G. College was established in 1984 to cater to the educational needs of the rural students from the villages in and around Movva mandal. The land of the college has been donated by the Local Philanthropists. The college is offering the following 3 year UG Programmes: B.A (H.E.P), B.Com (General), B.Com (Comp Appl), B.Sc (M.P.C), B.Sc (M.P.Cs), B.Sc (M.E.Cs), B.Sc (Bt. B.C), B.Sc (B.Z.C), B.Sc (M.P.WET), B.Sc (M.E.IoT) and also the following 2 year PG Programmes: M.Sc (Maths), M.Sc (Computers) and M.Com (Banking & Financial Services), M.Com (Accounting & Taxation).

The academic year 2021-22 started on 01-09-2021. At present we have 728 students on rolls, out of which 634 are studying UG courses and 94 are studying PG courses. We have 24 regular teaching staff, 3 contract faculty, 12 guest faculty and 6 regular non-teaching staff. The College went for first NAAC accreditation in 2004 and was awarded ‘B’ Grade, Second NAAC accreditation in 2011 and was awarded ‘B’ Grade with 2.56 CGPA and third NAAC accreditation in 2017 and was awarded ‘A’ grade with 3.01 CGPA.

Results:

The results of Degree and PG exams are quite encouraging and we are putting more efforts to improve them year by year. During the academic year 2020-21, the aggregate percentage of results in the UG final year examination is 72.52% and PG final year examination is 90.57%

NSS & NCC Activities:

There is an NSS unit with 100 volunteers and an NCC unit affiliated to 16 Andhra Battalion with a sanctioned strength of 100 cadets in the college. They are functioning efficiently under the aegis of NCC and NSS Co-ordinators and taking up various activities. They help to foster leadership qualities and service attitude among the students.

Student welfare:

The effective cooperation extended by our staff members in the smooth conduct of regular classes, study hours, co-curricular & extra-curricular activities and examinations needs special commendation. 30% of the passed out students are progressing to Higher education by taking admission in PG, B.Ed, and other programmes.

Awareness on competitive exams and PG entrance coaching is given for the outgoing and II year degree students through concerned departments, JKC and Career Guidance Cell. Guest Lectures by subject experts both in Offline and Online mode are organized by the respective departments. Rallies in connection with National Integration Day, Voters day and AIDS day are organized by our College NSS, NCC and Red Ribbon Club.
