## INTERNATIONAL DAY OF YOGA BY NSS

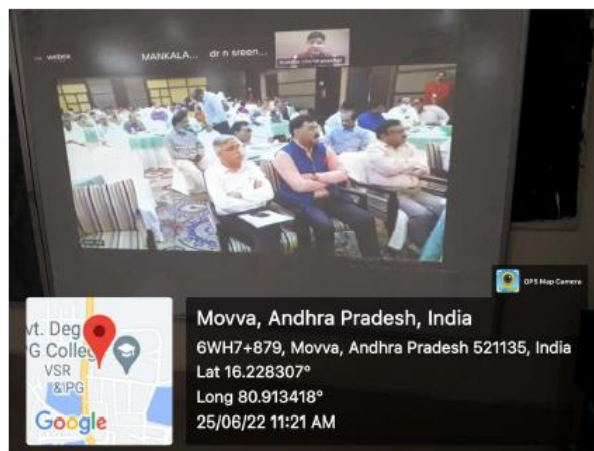
