Student Satisfactory Survey (SSS) was conducted among the students. The questionnaire was framed following the guidelines of the NAAC. The students have valued the questions on a scale of 1 to 4. The outcome of this survey is based on the response of the students. The summary is placed on the college website.

The observations of SSS are as follows:

- 1. Students appreciated teaching and implementation of learning outcome based curriculum which includes continuous evaluation and assessment of students throughout the semester.
- 2. They have also acknowledged various programs implemented. This has helped students in learning other concepts which were beyond their prescribed curriculum.
- 3. Students have expressed satisfaction over the quantum of syllabus covered in their classes and laboratories
- 4. Teacher's preparation, communication, use of appropriate teaching pedagogy and use of ICT has been rated good in the survey.
- 5. There is adequate encouragement to the students for extracurricular activities.
- 6. Teachers are able to identify weaknesses and help students to overcome them. Remedial classes are held for weak students.
- 7. Most of the students were of the opinion that the assignments have been regularly discussed with them and were up to their satisfaction.

- 8. The students found the communication skills of the teachers effective.
- 9. Students agree that College makes substantial efforts to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills.
- 10. Interactions between teachers/mentors and students were at desired levels where the mentors contributed in identifying competencies of the students to follow up their progress on assigned tasks.


The SSS has also pointed out few grey areas where the college/ teachers/ departments do have scope for enhancement in quality of education.

They are as follows:


- Institute needs to promote student exchange and field visit opportunities.

- Teachers should involve students in more projects, and research.

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






What degree program are you pursuing now?




How well did the teachers prepare for the class?




How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




How well were the teachers able to communicate? 334 responses




The teacher's approach to teaching can best to described as 335 responses




Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers 334 responses



Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 334 responses




The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, and field visit opportunities for students.




The teaching and monitoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth




The institute provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow




Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course, outcome and programme outcomes












The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process


