A REPORT ON THE OBSERVANCE OF NMBA ACTIVITIES

26-06-2025

Our College conducted activities to create awareness on The International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, or World Drug Day, marked on 26 June 2025 to strengthen action and cooperation in achieving a world free of drug abuse. This year's World Drug Day calls for investment in prevention, including justice, education, health care and alternative livelihoods — the building blocks of sustainable resilience.

In alignment with the national vision of a drug-free India under the Nasha Mukt Bharat Abhiyaan (NMBA), V.S.R.Government Degree & PG college organized a series of impactful activities to raise awareness about substance abuse and promote a healthy, addiction-free campus environment. These activities included a Student Rally, Poster Presentation, a Guest lecture by police personnel, an Online Quiz and Talks by faculty and students. The observance aimed to educate, engage, and empower the youth to actively participate in the fight against drug abuse, reflecting the core objectives of NMBA.

Objectives of the Programme

- To spread awareness about the dangers of substance abuse among students and the community.
- To encourage students to take a proactive stance against drug use.
- To provide factual information and support mechanisms for those at risk.
- To foster a sense of collective responsibility in building a drug-free society.

Activities Conducted

1. Rally by the Students

A vibrant rally was organized, with enthusiastic participation from students, staff, and NSS volunteers. The rally traversed key locations within and around the college campus, carrying banners and placards with anti-drug slogans. Students raised awareness by

chanting slogans and interacting with bystanders, conveying the message of a substance-free life. The event garnered positive reactions from the public.

2. Poster Presentation

A poster presentation competition was held, inviting creative expressions from students on the theme of drug abuse prevention. The posters depicted the harmful effects of drugs, the importance of mental health, and the role of youth in combating addiction. The best entries were displayed drawing attention from students, and faculty. This activity not only fostered creativity but also deepened participants' understanding of the issue.



3. Guest Lecture by Police Personnel

A guest lecture was delivered by a senior police officer, who shared real-life experiences and statistics related to drug abuse cases in the region. The officer highlighted the legal consequences of drug possession and trafficking, discussed the psychological and social impacts of addiction, and introduced available support systems such as helplines and rehabilitation centers. The session was interactive, with students asking questions about intervention strategies and ways to help peers in need. The lecture served as an eyeopener,

motivating students to act as ambassadors of the anti-drug movement.



4. Activities in Colloboration with Government Junior College

The GJC Movva conducted the event by inviting MRO,MPDO,DOCTER, and Police Department SI and other personnel. Our College students and Staff participated in the Programme. The Dignitaries delivered short talks focusing on the impacts of addiction, its impact on academic and personal life, and strategies for prevention and recovery. These talks emphasized the importance of peer support, healthy lifestyle choices, and the need for collective vigilance. Personal stories and case studies were shared, making the sessions relatable and inspiring. Our College Chemistry Lecturer, IQAC Coordinator and Vice Principal Smt.K.R.Manjula explained about This year's campaign "Break the cycle. #StopOrganizedCrime" highlighting the need for coordinated long-term action to break the cycle of organized crime and drug trafficking - by addressing root causes, investing in prevention and building stronger health, education and social system.






5. Say NO TO DRUGS PLEDGE was also taken by the students and Staff.
