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CHAPTER - 1

INTRODUCTION

Poultry is important in supporting the livelihoods of poor farmers, consumers, traders and laborers throughout the whole country. Small scale poultry production ranges from small semi-scavenging flocks of 10 to 30 indigenous breed birds in rural villages to 300 to 500 commercial improved breed birds managed with family labor in small-scale semi-commercial production systems. On a global basis, the contribution of poultry to livelihood improvement or poverty alleviation depends on a number of factors including the production system, Agro Ecological Zone and the socio-economic and enabling environment in the local community (Huque and Pym, 2007). This study was mostly based on experience in rural area in Barlapudi and inevitably there were some exceptions to the generalizations. Small-scale poultry farming increases the income of the farmers as well as increases the consumption of meat and eggs which in turn enhances the nutrition of the household. The major share of income from poultry is spent on other food items and on productive assets and savings (Rahman *et al.*, 2005; Karim *et al.*, 2005; Nielsen, 1998 and Sarker and Bell, 2022). Any form of food production depends on better integration of traditional knowledge with research the use of improved technology through training and improving farming practices through community development to increase outputs from current resources which may include low-cost finance to help poor farmers. Whatever the flock size or stock source, small-scale poultry farming is generally undertaken by families; as such, the contribution to national meat and egg production and consumption is substantial. This contribution from small scale indigenous semi-scavenging flocks has been estimated to account for 30 to 80 % of total production across a number of developing countries (Gueye, 2003). If small-scale commercial stocks are included,

the contribution increases. In addition to providing meat and egg, the sale of poultry products enables the families to obtain money to spend on their other food items for family needs. Poverty alleviation is one of the development agenda in Barlapudi like all other developing countries in the world, but it is generally accepted that availability of money alone is not enough to achieve success. It requires new ideas and concepts to utilize this money in a productive way to move out of the poverty. Small-scale intensive poultry rearing under a system of community management is one of the methods proven to be effective in reducing poverty in rural Barlapudi (Huque, 2002). The community poultry management concept under an enabling environment is an effective way of fighting poverty and improving food security, irrespective of production system and stock genotype. Hence this study was undertaken with objective to obtain the benefits and ideas of community based poultry production approaches for poverty reduction.

Statistics

- Among all the groups of poultry chicken stands tall with about 75 to 80% share of the entire poultry production
- India stands 3rd in egg production & 5th in poultry meat production
- Andhra Pradesh stands first in egg production followed by Tamilnadu, Karnataka & Telangana
- Tamilnadu stands first in meat production followed by maharashtra, AP, Telangana.
- Per capita consumption of eggs in India is 69/year and per capita consumption of meat is 2.96kg/year.

CHAPTER - 2

METHODOLOGY

The study was done based on formation and operation of a community poultry business at Technology Dissemination Area (TDA) of Poultry Management Technique Improvement Project (PMTIP) under Barlapudi Livestock Research Institute at Barlapudi under Joypurhat district of Barlapudi in 2022. A total of 100 small-scale broiler farmers were given seven days long family training (one male and one female from a household/family) on modern poultry production. A community Broiler Farmers Forum was formed with all trained small-scale commercial broiler farmers in a village of Barlapudi. All kinds of input like chicks, vaccines, medicine and output like broiler and litter selling services of community broiler farmers were operated by the community approach. Financial benefit is essential for successful formation and operation of a community through business approach. This study was produced based on the business experiences and ideas of community based Broiler Farmers Forum based for profitable and sustainable commercial small holder poultry farming in Barlapudi.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSIONS**Conduction of family training**

Family training is essential to improve farmers' skills and upgrade farmers' skills on a long-term basis. At least two members, one female and one male member were selected from existing broiler farmers of community for family training. More than two or whole family may also be trained. Training sessions were organized in segments with the consideration of other activities of the family duty. Training was conducted through full participatory as well as demonstration based. It was observed that family training was very much effective tool to transfer the improved poultry production technologies to poultry farmers for increasing their skill ness on poultry rearing.

Development of Local service providers

After completion of the training, farmers were nominated among them as a Local Service Provider (LPS) who got better understanding of the training subjects. Local service provider maintained a good liaison with the public veterinary service through the community service center for further technical service. A service share benefit should ideally be determined for the LPS. It is acknowledged that more improved training should be introduced gradually for LPS that works better for providing minimum technical service to the community farmers. As a result of LSP, community poultry farmers may be received their necessary technical services in time with minimum cost.

Small-scale poultry rearing

Small-scale poultry rearing can be financially beneficial whatever the stock (indigenous or commercial) used. In indigenous stocks, the meat and eggs produced almost constitutes at net profit for keepers, as it is a low input production (Gueye, 2003). On the other hand, small-scale intensive commercial stocks with 300-500 birds rearing can also be profitable, as family labor and local resources are the major inputs for them (Huque, 2002). So, small-scale poultry are capable of contributing significantly to poverty alleviation and food security in remote and disadvantaged groups. In our country, the rapid growth of poultry is fully dependent upon small-scale farmers. This activity provides an opportunity as a unique entry point for the younger members of the rural population to become engaged and reverse the poverty spiral. Management systems of small-scale poultry rearing can be categorized into four classes (Gueye, 2003), namely: 1) the free-range system or traditional village system: scavenging, no regular water or feed, little or poor night shelter; 2) the backyard or subsistence system: regular water, supplementary feeding, improved shelter, care of chicks in the first weeks, vaccination against Newcastle and other diseases (e.g. fowl pox, fowl cholera, Gumbro, coccidiosis), when necessary, and treatment for parasites, 3) the semi-intensive: as in (2), with genetically improved breeds and balanced diets and 4) the small-scale intensive system: as in (3), with further improvements in overall

Poultry Egg Production Trend in India



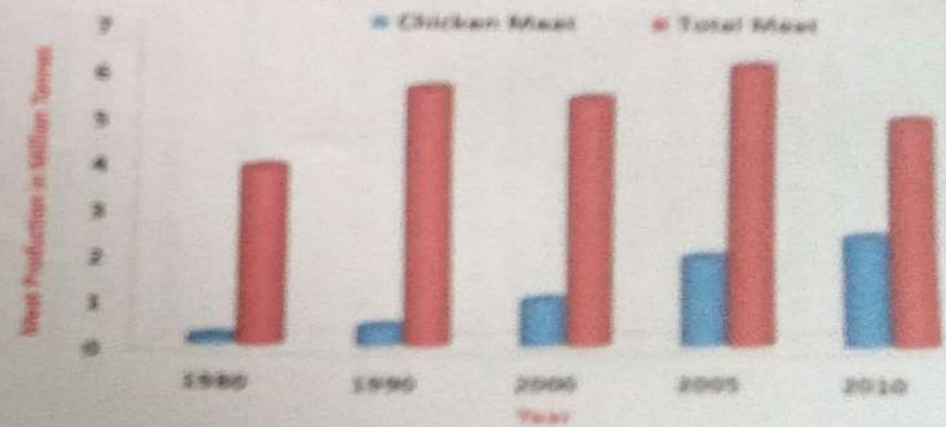
Indian Poultry Egg Production - World Ranking

husbandry conditions. All the systems are encountered in family poultry but the variation depends on the socio-economic-cultural conditions, market availability, electricity, resources and inputs i.e. breeds, housing, feeds, vaccines, medicines etc. The small-scale poultry farming constitutes indigenous stock, improved stock and small-scale intensive family broiler and layer operations of around 300 to 500 birds. This essentially forms the basis of small-scale intensive family poultry production in Barlapudi (Huque and Pym, 2007).

Formation of community broiler farmer's forum

A community farmer's forum named Broiler Farmers Forum (BFF) was formed with trained farmers by the initiative of TDA of PMTIP project. As they often faced difficulties with low prices for their products and high cost of inputs. Combining forces in a group may give direct benefit to the community farmers. Community forum formations may be effective means for increasing their income through community enterprise. In general, BFF for input and output services should be based on local initiatives with participatory involvement, combined with some help and encouragement from external sources. At the beginning, the external sources may initiate the community enterprise formation and the suggested steps for its development are as follows:

- Primary basic information survey
- Initial meeting of the stakeholders i.e. potential farmers (female and male), local leaders and local related public officials)
- Selection of the beneficiary farmers based on willingness and other selection criteria;
- Basic family (one female and one male) training (Demonstration mobile) on poultry offered for the community or group and follow-up training (Huque, 2002).
- Detail activities plan including resources required, housing with local resources, selection of the stocks, feeds, working areas, fund raising (members fees, savings, fund raising activities, grants, different forms of credit, development of emergency fund, etc.) and marketing (Huque, 2002).
- Formation of community enterprise/ forum/group management committee with their functions;
- Developing a constitution.
- Inaugural meeting.
- Formal linkage with a central registered organization / formal registration locally.
- Operation started.
- Organized weekly, fortnightly or monthly meetings on a regular basis for exchange of knowledge and to share the problems faced by the farmers.
- Local service provider (LPS) or resource farmers development including identifying input/output services, technological supports and share benefit of the service provider.

Community Resource Service Centre (CRSC)

The main elements in the enabling environments for the small-scale poultry are to allow for the establishment of local organizations like Community Resource Service Centre (CRSC) that work to ensure the resource linkage of vaccine/medication, breed/genotype/replacement stock, feed availability and quality, local housing materials, homestead scavenging areas, predators, technical know-how, diagnostic and advisory services, credit support, market linkages, organizational system and interest the family or farmers. With an enabling environment (Jensen and Dolberg, 2002), the poultry activity learning process may permit the family to move out of poverty. It is perceived as a first step out of poverty (Tood, 1997). A centre may take other social awareness issues like children education, polygamy, early marriage, dowry, homestead vegetable gardening, among the members.

Ways of sustainable small-scale poultry farming

Farming sustainability depends on the current local practices, resources availability and proper utilization (i.e. farmers. knowledge and practice, feed resources and availability, housing materials, required equipments, disease preventive vaccines and medicines etc.), capability of individuals, farmers and market chain development. Sustainability is also linked up to the perceptions, needs, priorities, interest and suggestions of the community farmers. Knowledge and profit is the most important segment for sustainable farming. To improve the skill and knowledge, training is the most important issues where efficiency of production fully lies on this. The following factors are the major elements of all four ways of small-scale poultry rearing for sustainability and profitability of poultry farming which can be undertaken through a farmer's organization named CRSC.

Input output service through CRSC

All input output will facilitate through community resource service centre and local service provider will primarily be responsible for this with the governance of the Executive Committee (EC) of the CRSC. This EC will be in term basis for operation of the centre. All inputs like feed, improved stock, medicines and vaccines and output like eggs and meat etc. will be operated through the centre. All technical assistance may be pooled for reducing cost of transportation, vaccines, drugs, veterinary assistance, etc.

Poultry value chain development

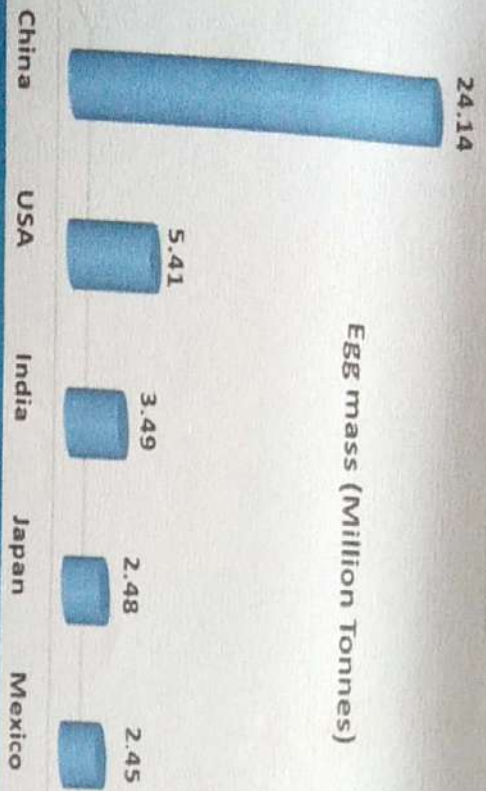
All the value chain sector should be identified and must be linked with the community. Small-farmers, traders of egg and meat, feeds traders, quality stock suppliers, vaccine suppliers, drug supplies, market identification, price determinant, transportation system, local public sector assistance, market linkage development, etc could be the value chain factors that management must be organized through the community centre.

Seasonal micro-credit

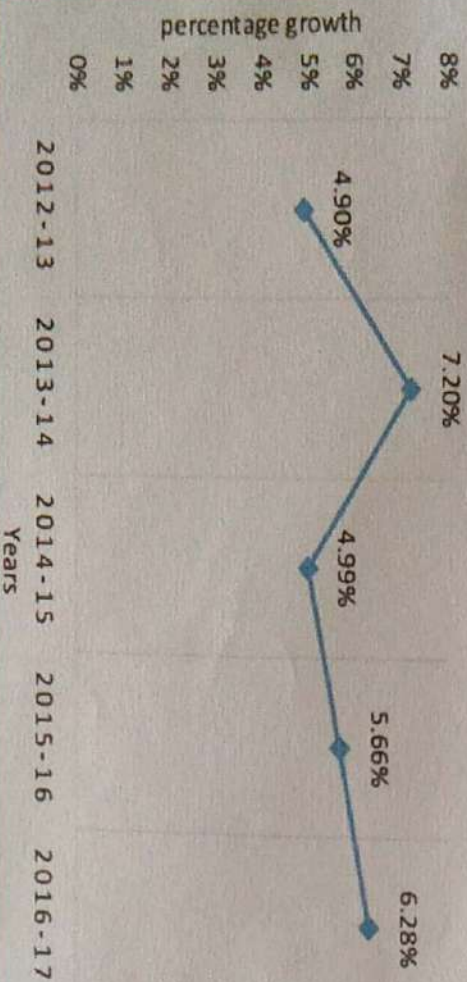
Micro-credit is an effective and powerful tool for small-scale poultry farming but the weekly installments repayment system are problematic when there is no income from poultry keeping. It needs adjustment with the traditional production system of

indigenous birds or small-scale broiler or small-scale layer farming. Credit in kind to interested small-scale poultry farmers by sharing her/his own investment can have a very positive effect within the structure of a community based farmers organization.

World Poultry Egg Production Scenario (2011)

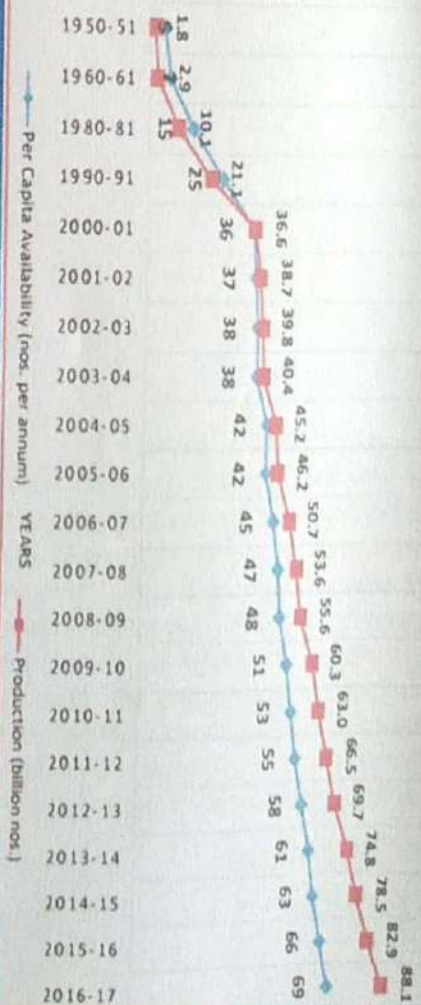


Graph 4.3: Annual Growth Rate Of Egg Production

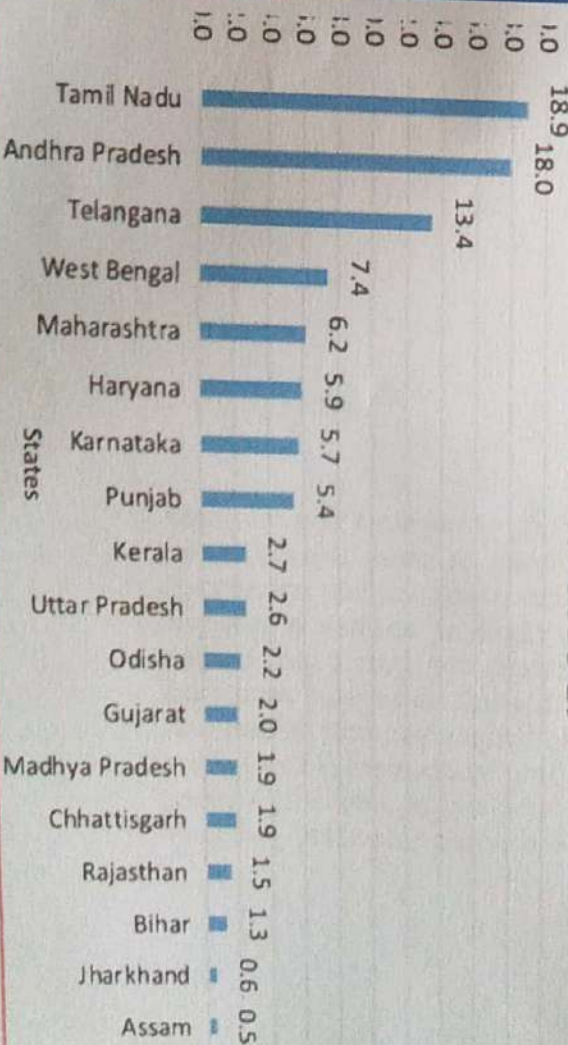


Egg Production graph
