ABSTRACT

The purpose of the study is to establish scientific rational for the use of the foresight methodology in the strategic planning of rural development. The scientific novelty of the study is determined by the development of an algorithm for strategic planning of rural development based on the foresight methodology and by the formation of a set of practical recommendations for the use of foresight tools at the municipal level of management in rural areas. The paper states that modern foresight methodology is quite flexible and multifaceted. It can be widely applied at different hierarchical levels of management. In our research, we consistently analyzed foresight projects and programs used in the rural management and development forecasting. The use of a systematic approach in combination with foresight technologies allows developing strategic plans for the rural areas development from the perspective of improvement of their economic and social component. The research presents the foresight algorithm of the rural development strategic planning and its implementation mechanism at the municipal level. The main components of the foresight testing procedure of the rural areas economic development were determined on the example of such a classic agricultural region of the Russian Federation as the Republic of Bashkortostan. The results of a comprehensive foresight analysis of alternative scenarios of the rural development have been formed. We summarized that the foresight technologies should be used as a system tool for the formation and implementation of the strategy of the sustainable rural areas development. The main results of the study include summarizing the experience of foresight studies on the rural areas development; design of an algorithm of strategic planning of the rural areas development based on the foresight methodology; the formation of alternative scenarios of the rural areas development at the regional level.

1. INTRODUCTION

Rural development usually refers to the method of enhancing the quality of life and financial well-being of individuals, specifically living in populated and remote areas.

Traditionally, rural development was centered on the misuse of land-intensive natural resources such as forestry and agriculture. However today, the increasing urbanization and the change in global production networks have transformed the nature of rural areas.

Rural development still remains the core of the overall development of the country. More than two-third of the country's people is dependent on agriculture for their livelihood, and one-third of rural India is still below the poverty line. Therefore, it is important for the government to be productive and provide enough facilities to upgrade their standard of living.

Rural development is a term that concentrates on the actions taken for the development of rural areas to improve the economy. However, few areas that demand more focused attention and new initiatives are:

- ❖ Education
- ❖ Public health and Sanitation
- ❖ Women empowerment
- ❖ Infrastructure development (electricity, irrigation, etc.)
- ❖ Facilities for agriculture extension and research
- ❖ Availability of credit
- ❖ Employment opportunities

2. OBJECTIVES

The objectives composed by the government in the plan for rural development are:

- ❖ To improve productivity and wages of rural people
- ❖ To guarantee increased and quick employment possibilities
- ❖ To demolish unemployment and bring a notable decline in underemployment
- ❖ To guarantee an increase in the standard of living of the underprivileged population
- ❖ To provide the basic needs: elementary education, healthcare, cleans drinking water, rural roads, etc.

- c. Training village people in the activities of planning and development.

2. Improving the Standard of Living of Villagers:

The main objective of Community Development Programmes is to improve the standard of living of the village people. They have been provided with various employment facilities and opportunities to set up industries and the training to improve their agricultural production. Cooperative societies and other such bodies have been set up for them to undertake various activities of development planning.

3. Political Training:

Through the Community Development Projects, village people are also given training in administrative activities. Through the working of Community Development Projects, people are trained in the practical working of democracy. The village people are trained in the area of civic affairs.

4. Other Objectives of Community Development:

The above mentioned objectives are the general objectives of the community development. There are also specific objectives intended basically at 'all-round Development of the Rural Society'.

The specific objectives of the plan may be categorized under the following heads:

- ❖ Agriculture and improvement of agricultural production
- ❖ Setting up of cooperative societies in each village
- ❖ Animal husbandry
- ❖ Public health
- ❖ Rural education
- ❖ Improving the means of communication and transport in rural areas
- ❖ Setting up village level small-scale cottage industries
- ❖ Organizing and strengthening the village panchayats

II. Underlying Philosophy and Principles of Community:

Development Projects:

Community Development Project is a new experiment in the development and planning activities of the world. Such projects have been specially launched only in Asian Countries. It is an experiment intended at fulfilling the various need of the village society and also making it self-dependent. It is a part of the Indian Constitution aimed at establishing a socialist society in this country.

The Community Development Programmes are based on the following principles:

- i. Drawing programmes for fulfilling various needs of the community.
- ii. Involving the people in planning and developmental activities.
- iii. Bringing about material as well as psychological betterment.
- iv. Teaching rural people, the political set up in democracy.
- v. Creating the local leadership.
- vi. Drawing up of national policy for the development of the country.
- vii. Setting up of cooperative societies for carrying developmental works.
- viii. Development based on socialism.

These Community Development Projects are based on the decentralization of economy, administration and political power. They are the means of training the people in the art of 'self-administration'. These programmes employ all the resources for the development of nation. They focus their attention at training

people to become self-dependent and self-reliant. These programmes are basically aimed at changing the face of rural society.

Features of Community Development Programmed:

This project in India is an integrated programme for rural development, which has the following features:

1. The basic characteristic feature of community development is self-dependence. It means that through this programme people are trained to become self-reliant economically.
2. To bring about a change in the administration is another important feature of community development.
3. The most important feature of this programme is the involvement of the people in the system.
4. All-round development of blocks is another important feature of community development.

Community Development Projects and their Implementation:

As already stated, these programmes are socio-economic programmes undertaken for the reconstruction of rural society; implementation is aimed at the involvement and participation of rural people, which is carried out by the institutions of local self-government and local administration.

Institutions for Implementation of Programmers:

The programmers of community development are carried out by the following three basic institutions at the village level:

- i. Village Panchayat
- ii. Cooperative Societies
- iii. Village School

In rural development and programmers of community development, the village school and the village teacher play a very vital role. The village teacher is the centre of activity and encourages people and involves them in the programme of village development and reconstruction.

Community Centers:

In villages, there are various community centers that look after the various aspects of life of village people.

These community centres perform the following functions:

1. Establishing reading rooms and libraries.
2. Encouraging village people to improve their standard of living.
3. Taking up various cultural programmes.
4. Establishing organizations for the welfare of boys and girls.
5. Establishing schools for the village children.
6. Undertaking the programmes of national integration and also observing national festivals to strengthen national unity.

Budgetary Planning:

As part of community project, it has been planned to set up blocks covering 100 villages with about 80,000 people. On the basis of this, all the states have been divided into blocks, regions and zones.

The budget is allotted to carry out the following stages of the programme:

1. Pre-extension Block Development
2. First stage of Block Development
3. Second stage of Block Development

Aspects of Community Development:**1. Community Development as a Process:**

Community development is intact a process and a method to bring about proper development and upliftment of the village society. This is a process to bring socio-economic changes at the social and psychological level.

2. Community Development as a Method:

Community development is not only a process of social change but also a method for achieving this objective. In a democratic country like India bringing about a change in the society can be possible only with the cooperation of the people.

3. Community Development as a Programme:

Community development is also a programme on the basis of which the process of change is carried out. Without proper programme, neither the method nor the process shall have any utility. This programme implies development of the society through stringent methods and process.

4. Community Development as a Movement:

Community development is a movement, which is undertaken for eradication of illiteracy, unemployment and poverty and improving village life.

Programmes of Community Development:

The Community Development Project has a large number of programmes intended to bring about the changes in the rural community.

The programmes included in the project are as follows:**1. Agriculture:**

Development of agriculture sector is the first aim of community development. The facilities include providing improved means of implements to the agriculturists, providing them with the improved seeds and better irrigation facilities and so on. The real task is to bring about the improvement in agriculture so that the condition of the rural society may improve.

2. Development of Communication:

Rural conditions improve only when the means of communication and transport in rural areas are developed. The project aims at construction of new roads and also improving transport and communication facilities.

3. Development of Education:

The Constitution of India envisages compulsory primary education. It stresses on adult education. Under Community Development Project, centers of social education, night schools and other institutions for imparting education have been planned. Apart from these libraries, reading rooms and centers of social education have to be set up. These institutions aim at expansion of education and extension of educational facilities.

4. Development of Health Services:

To improve the standards of rural life, one has to change facilities regarding health need improvement. It is done by providing facilities of medical and health services, maternity and child welfare services, etc. Provision of health services is one of the developmental measures taken up by Community Development Project.

5. Employment Facilities:

Rural societies are characterized by seasonal employment, as agriculture is the only means of livelihood. It also suffers from unemployment and underemployment. Community Development Programme aims at setting up small-scale cottage industries in rural areas, through which employment could be provided for rural people.

6. Housing Facilities:

Rural areas in India suffer from lack of proper houses. The houses in rural areas do not have the basic facilities and are unhygienic. The development programmes include providing better housing facilities.

7. Social Welfare Activities:

Social welfare activities such as providing better facilities for recreation, women's education have been taken up in Community Development Project.

RESERCH METHODOLOGY

Research Problem:

The issues of rural areas development in the region under current conditions are determined by a versatility and dynamism of different scientific approaches and methods to be applied for solving these issues.

These circumstances determine a special role of the foresight methodology and a systematic approach for designing rural development strategy. The use of these modern scientific methods allows assessing rural development from the perspective of prospective improvement of the economic and social component of the rural areas development. The algorithm of strategic planning of rural development designed with the application of foresight methodology is based on the formulation of the rural areas mission, hierarchical goal-setting, analysis of socioeconomic problems of rural development, and their ranking.

When making a foresight research, we take into account the natural resource potential, local specific conditions that determine the development of agricultural production, and location of social facilities and infrastructure in rural areas. Foresight research is based on a comprehensive approach, which involves examination of all elements of the studied territorial system (rural areas in total), including strategic objectives and the definition of relationships between the elements of the system.

We have to subscribe to the opinion of Heinz, who thinks that one of the most effective methods of foresight is scenario planning. This method helps to make such a choice of options for change in the studied organization, which in the future will allow achieving the goals.

When designing promising courses of rural areas development, it is necessary to use a scenario approach instead of strictly deterministic "solid" forecasts. As the academician of the Russian Academy of Sciences Altukhov emphasizes, "the scenario approach is one of the most effective system tools for strategy development, as its application provides a better understanding of the situation and assessment of potential threats and identification of favorable opportunities for determining the most likely activities of all spheres of the agro industrial complex, as well as increasing the level of their adaptation to changes in the external environment"

Integrated use of foresight technologies as well as scenario approach application allows identifying the most favorable in socioeconomic terms rural areas as "potential growth points" of the agricultural sector. Thus, special attention can be paid to depressed rural areas which are a kind of "incubators of poverty" at the zonal level. Scenario approach

specifies choice diversity and alternativeness of a trajectory of the sustainable development strategy.

Alternative scenarios for the development of rural areas are formed on the basis of foresight technologies with the involvement of the expert community.

Expert's study of strategic directions of the rural areas development involves two rounds. Pre-poll training of experts is carried out before each round. In order to get valid results before the second round, the results of the first round were analyzed and registered. Then, experts were acquainted with them. After the second round, the final analysis was carried out, and the results of the entire expert survey were presented. 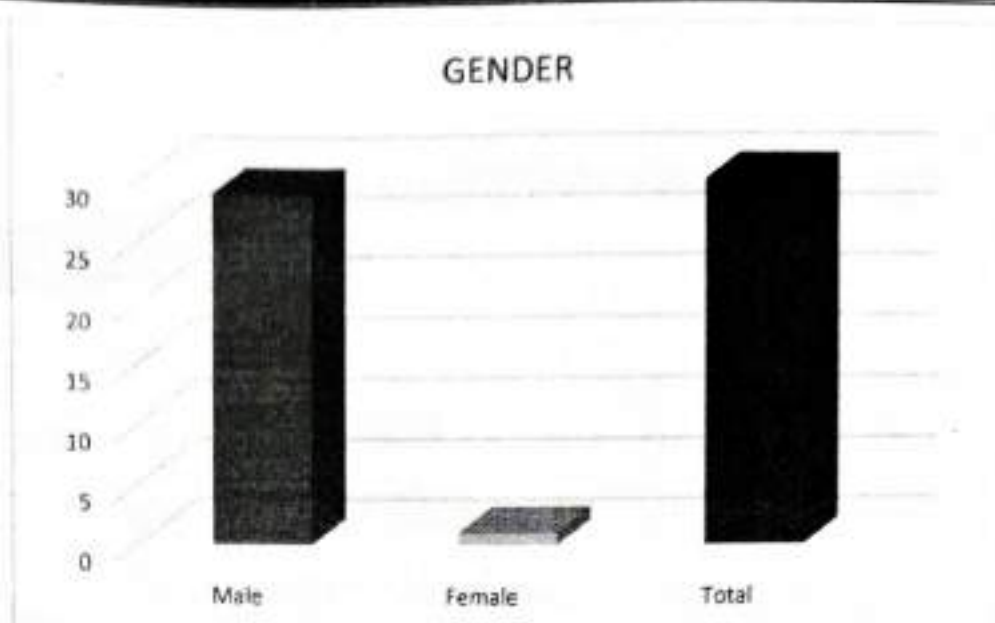

Interpretation: Females -01

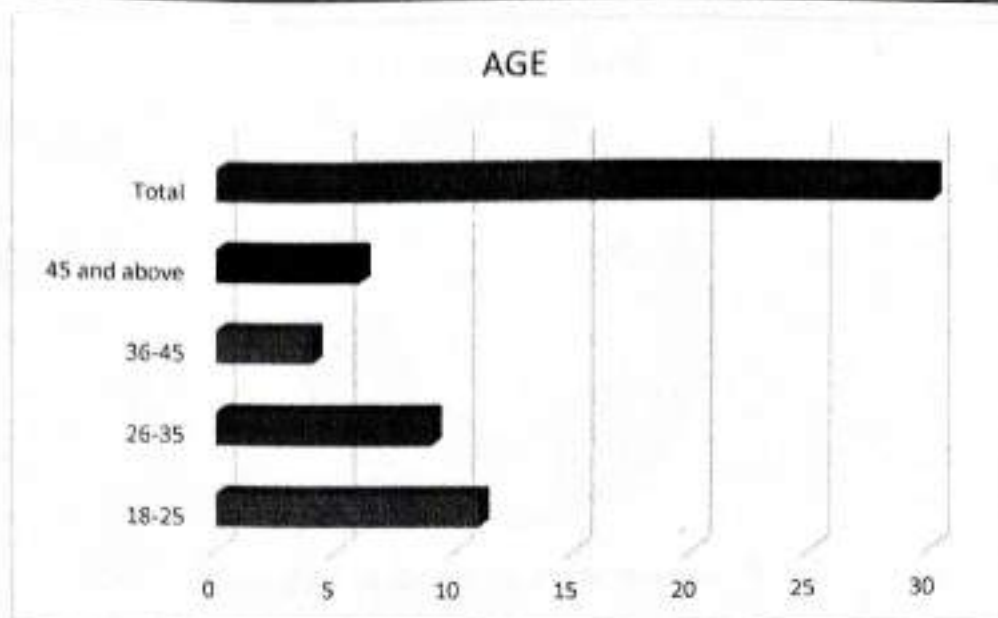

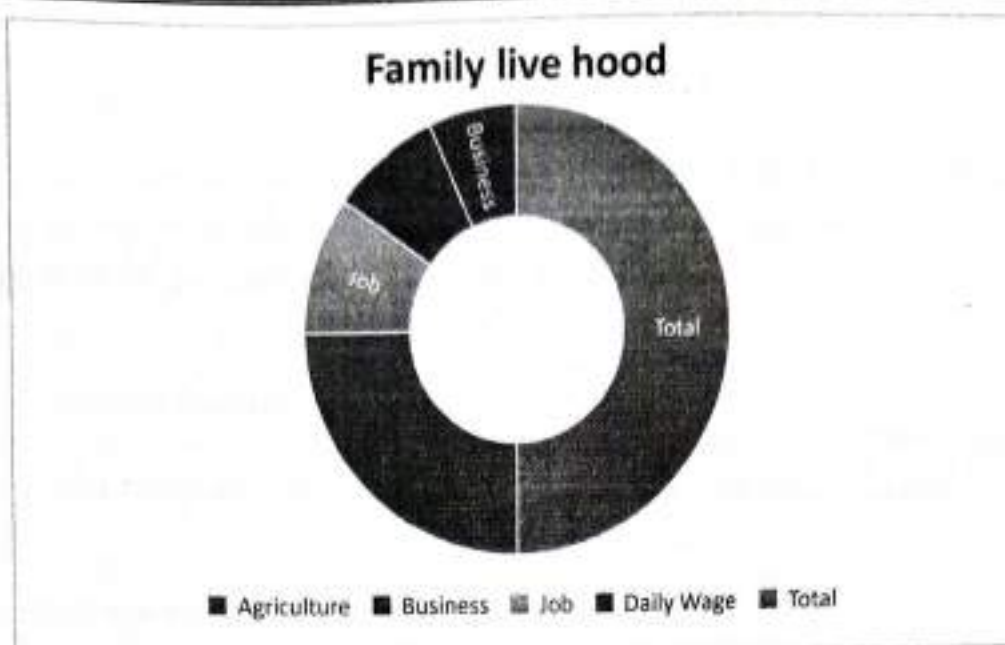

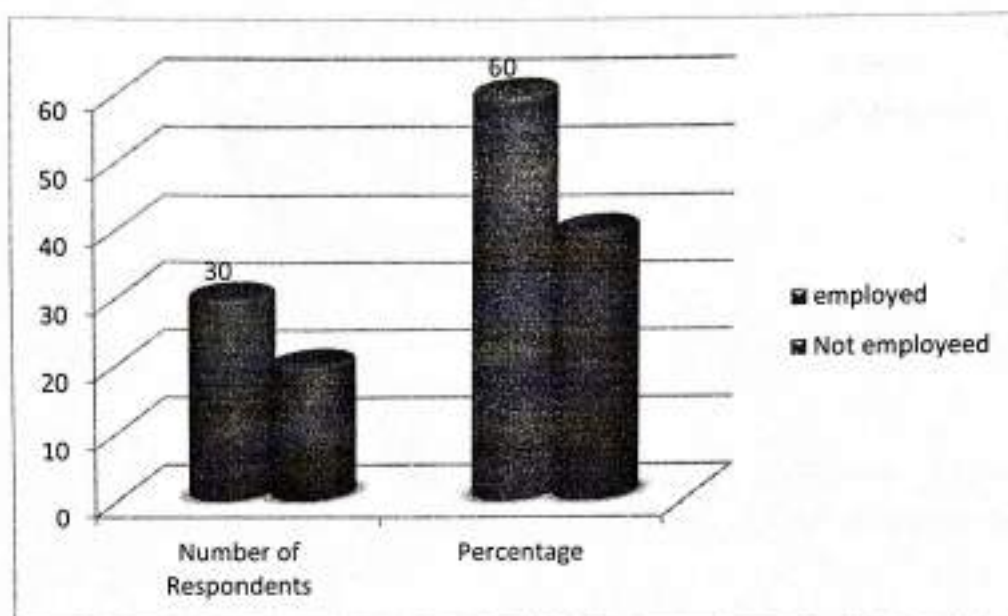

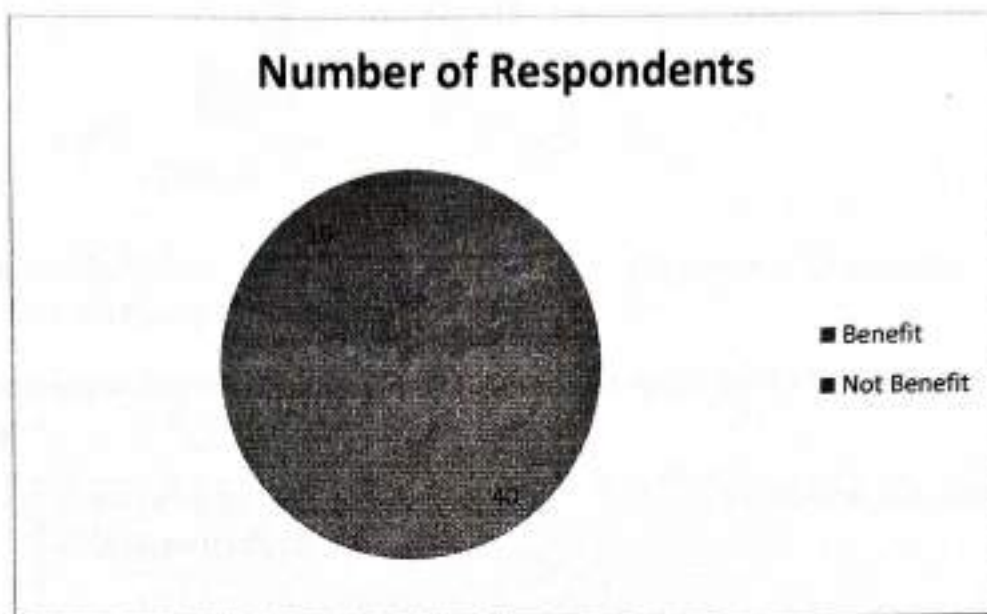

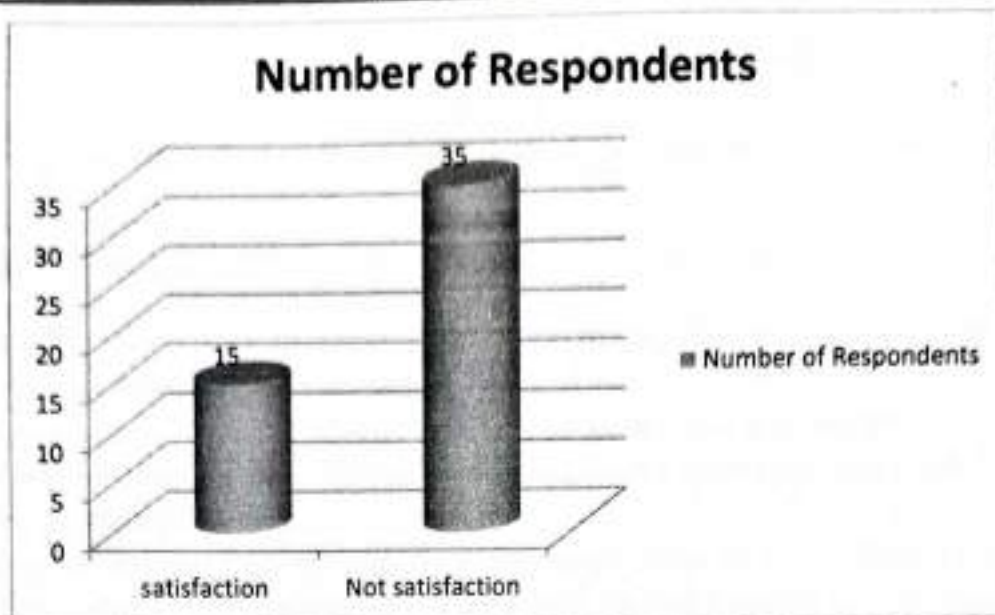

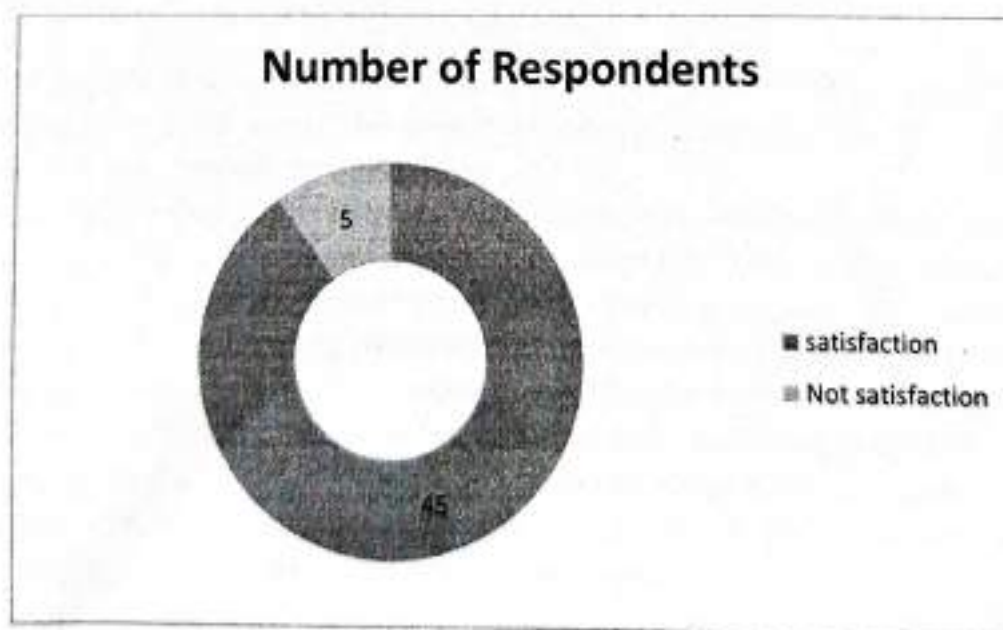

RECOMMENDATIONS OR SUGGESTIONS:

The real duty of the government is to help the people to improve agriculture so that the conditions of the rural community can be improved.
- ❖ Rural conditions will only improve when communication and transportation facilities are developed in rural areas. The project should aim to build new roads and improve transport and communication facilities.
- ❖ The Constitution of India refers to compulsory primary education. This puts pressure on adult education. Under the Community Development Project, social education centers, night schools and other institutions are required to plan for providing education. Apart from these libraries, reading rooms and social education centers should be set up. These institutions should aim to expand education and expand educational facilities.
- ❖ To improve rural living standards, facilities need to be changed in relation to improving health needs. Provide facilities such as medical and health services, maternity and child welfare services. Providing health services is one of the development initiatives undertaken by the Community Development Project.
- ❖ Rural communities should be characterized by seasonal employment, because agriculture is the only source of livelihood. It also suffers from unemployment and low employment.

The Community Development Program should aim at establishing small scale cottage industries in rural areas through which employment can be provided to the rural people.

- ❖ Rural areas in India are suffering from lack of proper housing. Houses in rural areas have minimal amenities or are unsanitary. Improved housing facilities should be provided in development programs.
- ❖ The community development project should include better facilities for recreation and social welfare activities such as women's education.

Conclusions

Thus, the author's concept of strategic development of rural areas of the region is based on the following:

1. Identification of rural development key problems to be solved as part of a foresight project: analysis of these problems, their relevance and socioeconomic significance, and possible limitations;
2. Analysis of the current development of rural areas in the region, highlighting the main trends, directions, and potential of their development, the definition of "problem" rural areas, scientific justification of the use of a system of methods to eliminate imbalances in the socioeconomic development of rural areas, and a comprehensive forecast of rural development.

The results of the study are as follows:

1. Theoretical approaches and positions on the strategic planning of the rural areas development on the basis of the foresight methodology have been generalized. The international experience has been systematized. The opportunities of the strategic planning of rural areas with the use of foresight technologies have been assessed.
2. There has been designed an algorithm of the strategic planning of rural development on the basis of the foresight methodology, consisting of preforesight, foresight, and post foresight stages
3. When using foresight technologies, alternative scenarios for the development of rural areas have been formed.
4. On the basis of the scenario approach, the projects of production value of food and its consumption for the considered rural areas have been designed.
5. Strategic planning of rural development on the basis of foresight methodology will improve the quality of a decision-making process at the municipal and regional levels of government. It will become possible to develop in time measures aimed at reducing imbalance between different layers of rural residents, to reduce rural society stratification and to make odds even in the rural areas society. The use of modern foresight technologies together with the system analysis not only helps to quickly diagnose the current state of rural areas but also contributes to spot "bottlenecks" and to reveal problems in the system
